Registration

- Registration
 - Registration will be open September 13 24, 2021
 - All attendees and presenters must register online during this time
 - Late registrations will not be accepted.
- Free Registrations/Lodging
 - Free registration and lodging will be provided for the first 250 registrants who are representing a Title I funded N&D institution or LEA.
 - Free registrations per institution or LEA are not limited this year.
- Meal Costs
 - Meals costs are the responsibility of the registrant.
 - The meal package is required to be purchased for anyone staying at the lodge and should be paid at hotel check-in via cash, check, money order, or credit card in the amount of \$162.00 per person.
 - Meal costs are a Title I allowable travel expense and participants may request reimbursement from their institution or LEA.
- Non-Free Registrations
 - Registrations for non-Title I institutions and LEAs will be accepted for the cost of lodging at \$308.00 per person.
 - Meals will need to be purchased upon hotel check-in.
 - The cost of lodging must be received by Friday, October 1, 2021, or registrations will be cancelled.
